Message from Administration

Dear Members,

HSNC administration focus for last few months was raising funds for purchasing 301 and 305 Aviation Pkwy land parcels to protect the temple campus integrity. With God's grace, we have good news to share- the society has purchased the property for \$708K. Our Constitution requires we have 50% of the funds raised before purchasing. There is tremendous support from the community by opening their wallets and generously donating to the society for this cause. We have received more than \$380k in donations and pledges. We have used \$135,000 from Shikhar Account to purchase the land. HSNC paid down payment of \$458,253 and borrowed \$250,000 from Aviation Parkway Temple, LLC, a well wisher entity.

You are probably aware that previous owner had filed a re-zoning application. If it had been approved, the zoning regulation would have required the society to provide a cross connection directly behind the temple. Many of you, especially the senior group were helpful in raising your voice and attended several town hall meetings with BOT and BOD to oppose re-zoning. Finally, to arrive at an amicable solution, the society decided to purchase the property.

Overall, these land parcels are critical for future HSNC campus and expanded or new Temple. We are now one more parcel closer to our dream campus.

Thanks to Donors, volunteers that helped raise the funds and well-wishers for supporting HSNC all the way. Thanks to the trustees and directors who helped raise the funds and also donated. Special thanks to Mr. Sajjan Agarwal for encouraging us constantly and playing a key role in contract negotiations and purchasing, and to Sharma Aunty who is working hard to help us reach the goal.

We still have a long way to go, to collect remaining pledges and raise more to pay off the loan of \$250K to Aviation Pkwy Temple, LLC. and replenish Shikhar Fund with \$135,000. We encourage members to donate generously if they have not donated as yet. All donations of \$1,000+ will be organized on the donor wall appropriately. We need a commitment from many more families to achieve the goal. Society has come together to work towards realizing HSNC Campus dream, and has proven what HSNC community is capable of doing. Let's keep the drive on.

One another operational update, we have released Mr. Krishnakant Adhyaru from priest duties, and have started the process to hire new priests. If anyone knows any priests with permanent residency in US, looking for the priest position, please refer them to us. Any help from any volunteer priests is also very much appreciated.

Thanks to Sudha Rathie, Amar Singh, Suvas Shah, Ram Chandran, Sunil Jain and Ashvin Panchal who helped draft revised election Process.

We are evaluating the quotes for Temple AC replacement and duct repairs and work will start in Oct/Nov, followed by paint and interior improvement.

Note: Excerpt from Article 4.2 of the Second Amended and Restated Constitution of the Hindu Society of North Carolina, adopted on January 20, 2018.

Each Director shall be required to be a Member of the Society during his or her term of office and for at least the three (3) consecutive full calendar years immediately prior to the beginning of such Director's term of office. A director's residence shall be within a one (1) hour drive of the Society's principal office. A director shall not have any criminal conviction other than minor traffic incidents such as speeding tickets or parking tickets. No Director can serve consecutive terms on the BOD. The spouse of any Director or Trustee cannot simultaneously serve as Director or Trustee.
