SPOTLIGHT: MIPSO TRIO

Google the word "Mipso," and you won't find much, because the word doesn't exist. But look up "Mipso Trio," and you'll find a band of three UNC students writing their own songs, singing great harmonies and defining their own style.
Comprised of Jacob Sharp on mandolin, Wood Robinson on upright bass and Joseph Terrell on guitar, Mipso Trio draws frequent comparisons to Mumford & Sons and The Avett Brothers. However, a close listen to their songs proves that while the influences of the aforementioned bands are present, the sound the trio is creating is distinctly their own.
Mipso Trio's upcoming gigs will take the band from the radio to the live stage, a nod to their local popularity and talent. The guys will be on *The State of Things* with Frank Stasio at noon this Friday



and will perform at Cat's Cradle on Saturday with Jim Avett and Overmountain Men.
Doors open at 8 p.m. and the show starts at 8:30. Tickets are \$8 in advance and \$10 the day of the show – but with the band's tendency to sell out venues, it's recommended that you get your tickets early to see what is sure to be a fantastic show.

Bands performing are Above Gravity, Alvern Santos and His Compadres, Completely Off Balance, Oxygen Morons, The Shy Guys, The Youngmen, Right of Way and On the Record.
Money from tickets sold will go toward the Cedar Ridge High School International Baccalaureate Program. Tickets are \$8 in advance and \$10 the day of the show, with doors opening at 6 p.m. and the first band going on at 6:30.
