Policy and Procedure Manual Committee

The usefulness of this last part lies in the fact that it will allow an individual at HSNC to find the information of interest in the entire manual easily and quickly! The goal of the committee is to submit the completed product in the form both a hard copy and an electronic copy to the administration well before the end of the year, preferably by October 31, 2019.

Note: Excerpt from Article 4.2 of the Second Amended and Restated Constitution of the Hindu Society of North Carolina, adopted on January 20, 2018.

Each Director shall be required to be a Member of the Society during his or her term of office and for at least the three (3) consecutive full calendar years immediately prior to the beginning of such Director's term of office. A director's residence shall be within a one (1) hour drive of the Society's principal office. A director shall not have any criminal conviction other than minor traffic incidents such as speeding tickets or parking tickets. No Director can serve consecutive terms on the BOD.


