Policy and Procedure Manual Committee

The committee has completed the preliminary draft and submitted hard copies in form of 3-ring binders to the directors and the trustees for review and input. The committee also met with the two boards in a joint session on July 9, 2019, and presented the status report on the work, highlighting all that has been completed, all that is in the process currently, and the time line for completing and submitting the final product.

Current Status:

The bulk of the manual has been completed and submitted to the two boards for input and suggestions for revisions. A deadline of August 31 has been proposed for receiving comments from the administration. While this is happening at the board levels, the committee is itself busy reviewing the forms used at HSNC and revising them to make them simpler and more functional. The only other major part currently remaining is the last part, the Cross Index, which will wait till all revisions have been incorporated and the pages numbered sequentially. The usefulness of this last part lies in the fact that it will allow an individual at HSNC to find the information of interest in the entire manual easily and quickly! The goal of the committee is to submit the completed product in the form both a hard copy and an electronic copy to the administration well before the end of the year, preferably by October 31, 2019.

Note: Excerpt from Article 4.2 of the Second Amended and Restated Constitution of the Hindu Society of North Carolina, adopted on January 20, 2018.

Each Director shall be required to be a Member of the Society during his or her term of office and for at least the three (3) consecutive full calendar years immediately prior to the beginning of such Director's term of office. A director's residence shall be within a one (1) hour drive of the Society's principal office. A director shall not have any criminal conviction other than minor traffic incidents such as speeding tickets or parking tickets. No Director can serve consecutive terms on the BOD.
