Dear Members,

The summer is almost over and we hope you had a great time during the summer with family, relatives and friends. Certainly, many of you took the time off to travel and explore the world as well as making a homage trip to India. Summer always brings back memories and reminds many of us our "summer vacation" experiences and ventures growing up in India and now keeping the same tradition alive by giving similar experience to our next generation born and raised in the U.S.

Speaking of traditions, this year, month of August coincided with "*Shrawan*" one of the most auspicious month full of various traditions and rituals. At HSNC, the temple and our priests stayed very busy with steady flow of devotees doing daily *puja* and *abhishek* throughout the month. HSNC witnessed another key tradition of celebrating India's (71st) Independence Day on Aug 12th in front of State and Local dignitaries. It was a very proud moment for all Indians in the triangle area to see US, NC and India flags hoisted showering flower paddles in presence of NC Governor Roy Cooper, Secretary of State Elaine Marshall, Mayors of Morrisville and Cary, etc. This year parade was within the HSNC campus with large turnout of cheerful Indian community. Hindi class children did great job singing both, Indian and US national anthems. Thank you HVM for organizing and managing the flag ceremony followed by the cultural program in main hall.

This month, HSNC also made another history – *Murti Pran Pratisthapana* of Shri Radha-Krishna in the main altar with 3 days of traditional rituals leading to *Pratisthapana* on the auspicious day of Janmastami. Lord Krishna *janam* was a grand event attended by hundreds of devotees, doing *kirtan-bhakti* and welcoming the lord at mid-night, 1st time in front of new murties. The celebration continued with a 7-day *Shrimad Bhagwat Katha* in hindi by Shri Devkinandan Thakur Ji Maharaj of Vrindaban in the temple hall. Big thank you goes to our priests, religious committee, facility staff and religious liaison Manisha Patel for arranging and making these series of event successful.

This year, keeping the HSNC tradition, we successfully completed 4 summer camps for community children. Kudos to the Om Squad team and volunteers led by Pinki Tapiawala for job well done. As per a group of members request, we introduced 3rd yoga session on every Monday evening. Please spread the words and take advantage of this new offering by contacting Mrs. Madhu Dev. When we talk about traditions, how can we not talk about HSNC's rich history of celebrating Ganesh Festival, Navratri Mahotsav, Dushahra and Diwali Annakut!! Each respective committee for these festivals is very busy already planning for weeks to ensure your experience is enriched and traditions kept alive. Stay tuned for the annual Gala dinner announcement in upcoming newsletter.

We have installed a new large air conditioning unit in the back for the main hall at a cost of \$20,000. This was one of the last original unit we had not replaced since the hall was built in year 2000. We made

very good progress in getting Learning Center (LC) open items closed with the builder, including completion of the side parking lot repairs at no cost to HSNC. The nameplates installation on the donor wall is now under taken. We regret the delay in getting this work done but hopeful to have it done in September. It is still not late to either add or upgrade your nameplate. For example, if you had donated \$500 before, you can donate additional \$500 to have your nameplate installed OR if you already have a \$1000 nameplate then you can upgrade it to next level to \$2500, and so on. Facility team also upgraded playground landscape with new playground grade mulch in playing area. Thanks to Gaurang Shah for driving facility repairs and closing remaining LC construction items working with contractor.

The Campus Development Committee had its kick-off meeting this month. They will start looking into next steps on long term planning and set some priorities to initiate several work streams. With guidance and active participation from trustees, the areas to consider would be: land acquisition opportunity adjacent to HSNC properties, rezoning, meet and discuss proposals presented by affiliate organizations on co-location, create blue print for campus, etc... This committee will be transitioned under trustees management once the constitution changes are approved.

HSNC is very grateful to Mr. Ishawar Murarka for keeping his summer tradition alive by sponsoring the beautiful flower beds landscaping around the temple building. This year, he was generous enough to install a sprinkler system in this area to make sure flower plants gets watered routinely. We are very proud of Dr. Sudha Om Dhingra, a long time HSNC life member, for being named in the RAHI rankings for 2017 of Top 100 Present Hindi Writers of the World. Congratulations to Dr. Dhingra. Please keep writing and inspiring others in Hindi literature.

As communicated in previous month newsletter, we would like to update you on two very important priorities that board of directors (BODs) and board of trustees (BOTs) have been working along with respective committees. The 2008 Election Policy has been revised, updated and approved by BODs and BOTs. It is posted on the HSNC website for members to review. We are very appreciative of persistent work done by this committee under the leadership of Mrs. Sudha Rathie. Equally important, Constitution Amendment draft is now completed by the committee and it is going through the final review. It will be made available to the members for their review and feedback before the end of Sept and before it is sent out for member's approval voting.

The final deadline for \$100 member to renew the membership with annual \$25 renewal payment was Aug 15th. Several reminders and multiple extension of deadline were given. Those members didn't renew by Aug 15th are no longer member of HSNC and will not receive voting ballots in this year election. The board has realized this is turning into a very tedious, complex and time consuming administrative tasks to execute for committee as well as members. As a result, only 91 out of 226 members renewed their membership in spite of extra efforts and communications by board and committee. We thank you membership committee for managing and keeping the records up-to-date.

As always, thank you for your help and support to keep the **HSNC First** as we continue work on establishing fair and responsible governance with transparency and accountability.

Message from Directors

Dear members,

Learning Center usage has been ramping up gradually. We have new rates for all agreements signed for Learning Center (LC) facility usage in 2017 to cover the increased operating and mortgage cost. We have 3 long term contracts signed last year and have signed 6 new long term contracts since May and 4 more are in the process of signing. For availability of learning center please check hsnconline.skedda.com and then send an email to rental@hsnconline.org. The rental rates are posted in the flyer and on the website. LC is quickly becoming popular learning destination in Triangle for Hindu Religion, Culture, and Arts.

Our facility usage is also increasing in terms of number of attendees in most events. So maintenance overhead and emergency repairs for existing facilities is also increasing significantly.

HSNC: Symbol of Hindu Unity among Diversity

HSNC is an open membership based religious organization where administration is elected democratically. That is a major difference in governance structure from most other religious organizations around the world. With this kind of structure, HSNC has been able to establish as a major religious and cultural center for Hindus and Indians of triangle area.

HSNC is a symbol of unity for all streams of Hinduism and allied philosophy. Our strength is promoting common foundational values of Hinduism while accommodating several different religious and spiritual practices. We don't have an influence of any specific Guru Ji in how organization is run or what kind of specific worshipping rituals are performed. And that is a good aspect, because we get opportunity to hear from many different scholars coming from multiple branches of Hinduism and at the same time avoid possibilities of blind faith in any single individual or a group. Lack of a single spiritual leader or vertical hierarchy could often make it difficult to raise funds. HSNC is a result of aspirations and inspirations of all Hindus in Triangle, who desires to have a place for future Hindu generations. Our future generations in US are least likely to identify themselves as Vaishnav, Jain, or believer of Ganesh, Ram-Sita, Radha-Krishna, Shiv, Venketeshwara, Gayatri, Swaminarayan, Sai, Dada Bhagwan or Brahma Kumari. Almost all of our next generation will identify themselves as Hindus. So let's open up our hearts and wallets to build the HSNC campus, which is for all Hindus.

Update from Constitution Committee

As you all know, Directors and Trustees have undertaken an important task of Constitution Amendment for last three months. BoD and BoT are actively engaged with the constitution committee appointed in earlier this year and headed by Dr. Ram Chandran (chair), Dr. Subhash Chandra (co-chair) and Dr Jalyan Parikh (co-chair) along with several long term veteran volunteers of society. The Committee has met 15 times during May, June and July 2017 and discussed various available options for consideration. The merits of the proposed changes have been thoroughly debated to arrive at a proposal that is best for the better governance of HSNC. The initial draft of the amendment is aimed to achieve the following high level objectives.

Key Changes Proposed in the revision of the Constitution:

- Provide clarity on Directors and Trustee roles and responsibilities. Integration of Article 4A (Trustee amendment) into main article 4
- Improve stability of the Committees by longer tenure with staggered changes in members
- Add checks and balances in important areas like Finance, elections, grievances, dispute resolution, internal audit, and campus development
- Increase number of directors to nine with longer, 3 year term.
- Add Mediation and Arbitration Panel as binding internal Arbitration process or mandate for any grievance and disputes prior to pursuing legal actions
- Simplify membership to annual and yearly with minimal dues and membership categories for recognition based on lifetime contribution
- Shared Financial Control by Directors and Trustees.
- Protection of Real Estate and Digital Assets.

Constitution committee has the draft of the amendment almost ready to send for broader review by the general membership finally a legal review by an attorney. Finally, an edited review after getting clearance from the Attorney will be sent to members for approval.

Constitution committee will hold an Information session for Members to hear about the amendment and provide input at 4:00-6:00PM on Saturday, Sept. 9, in Learning Center room #1 and 2.
