“Some teachers have revoked their recommendation letters,” Ellis said.

Lynn Lehman, a parent of a student at Chapel Hill High and vice president of the school’s Parent-Teacher-Student Association, said in an email response to inquiries from *The Citizen* that she hopes the school community will learn from the incident.

“Our community is competitive, and our students feel that,” Lehman said. “As seniors, they are experiencing probably the most conflicting time of their young lives. They are feeling like they have to have it all figured out. They want to please their parents. They want to be loyal to their friends. But we need to remember that they are still kids.”

Lehman said she was concerned about the privacy of the students involved and the morale at the school.

“It is hard to improve the morale at the school when the TV camera

trucks are parking outside and the rumors are flying,” she said.

Ellis said students and teachers are discussing cheating and integrity in their homeroom classes and will discuss the incident in their English classes next week. She added that the school earlier this year formed an honor and integrity committee to develop plans to curb cheating at the school.

Student government requested an assembly to discuss the incident, but Ellis said she wants to wait until things settle down before meeting with the entire student body.
