

Neither the Journal nor the Society can assume responsibility for errors on the part of contributors. Corrections of proved errors will appear in a subsequent issue of the Journal. Queries are free to all individual Society members who submit a pedigree chart. Non-members are charged \$4.00 per query.

#### FOOTNOTES OF HISTORY

#### Notes From A Cluttered Desk

Facts gleaned from the notes of a historian's cluttered desk:

10-INCH SNOW - The Watchman reported that Salisbury had a 10-inch snow on March 8, 1872.

THE SALISBURY INSTITUTE opened in August, 1871, in the academy building in back of the Presbyterian Church, according to an announcement in The Old North State. The institute was to be under the management of B. Frank Rodgers of Concord and The Rev. J.G. Neiffer of Salisbury.

ON SEPTEMBER 15, 1871, the cornerstone of the Evangelical Lutheran Church at Mt. Pleasant was laid. The announcement stated that the church was to be "a brick edifice."

LUTHERAN CHURCH - The North Carolina Herald carried an article in the December 3, 1885, issue stating the Lutheran Church was about completed. This church, now located behind a service station on the corner of Kerr and Main Streets is still standing.

KLUTTZ'S DRUG STORE (now Purcell's on the corner of Main and Innes) had a new metal roof installed in November, 1885. Not to be outdone, Maj. S.W. Cole the same month improved his building on the corner of Fisher and Main Streets with an iron front.

THE WESTERN CAROLINIAN reported in 1830 that "the Salisbury Races of the Jockey Club began on October 27<sup>th</sup>. There was no bullying and fighting but the whole passed off with good feelings. A great many ladies were present in their carriages."

SCOTTISH BANK - The First National Bank Building (now the Scottish Bank) was completed during the week of August 2, 1885, with I.H. Foust as cashier.

MR. JOHN M. KNOX and Mrs. G.A. Bingham homes have just been built. They are two-story, L-shaped with piazzas, bay windows, fancy ornaments and finished in tinted paints. (Watchman, March 8, 1872) These lovely homes on West Bank Street are now occupied by John Knox's daughter, Miss Clara Knox, and by Mr. and Mrs. John L. Henderson.

THE STAGE OFFICE is kept at the Rowan House for C. Lucas and Company Lines which serve passengers from Salisbury to Charlotte, Danville, Richmond, Petersburg, and for P. Warlick's Lines from Salisbury to Morganton and Raleigh. (Salisbury Banner, November 24, 1854)

WILLIAM ROWZEE was agent for the Tri-Weekly Mail Line from Mocksville to Salisbury with the "two horse hacks." (Watchman, January 11, 1859)

ON NOVEMBER 24, 1854, Peter Kearns died at the age of 68, and on January 11, 1859, McNeely and Young's new store on the corner opposite the Mansion House was formerly occupied by Michael Brown. This would be Bailey's Drug Store.

JOHN McCLELLAN of the Parish of Shronell County of Tipperary, Ireland, oldest son of Robert and Elizabeth McClellan, sold Rowan County land to John Haglitt of the same place. McClellan "served as an officer under Washington in the late American War and after the peace settled in or near Salisbury. He died in 1788. (Deed Book 13, page 548.)






#### **Early Landowners of Rowan County**

Rowan Public Library, the Edith M. Clark History Room, and the Genealogical Society of Rowan County are proud to announce that the Early Landowners of Rowan County maps, along with the index, have been digitized and published to the History Room website as our newest digital collection.

In 1995, James W. "Bill" Kluttz published a set of 6 maps that indicated the earliest land purchases in the area of North Carolina we now identify as Rowan County. While Rowan County in 1753 covered a much greater area than its current acreage, the maps feature only the land plats in the area that is currently Rowan. The Early Landowners of Rowan County, North Carolina maps, also known as the Kluttz Maps, originated in the work done in 1950s by David Rendleman. In his research, Kluttz also included portions of western Rowan that had not been previously incorporated in any plat map studies. Listed on each map within the property lines are the deed book and page number of the earliest deed reference as well as the grantor, grantee, and date of the sale. There are 1,200 names within the grantor/grantee lists. The Kluttz maps are invaluable for genealogical research in this area. These maps are accessible online by entering the History and Genealogy section of the library website, then the Edith M. Clark History Room link, click on the drop down menu for "Collections" and select the Kluttz maps or the Kluttz map index to explore for specific surnames.

A set of 6 maps and the index to the map can be purchased through the Genealogical Society for \$35.00. Sets are also available for viewing or purchase at the Rowan Public Library History Room. The deed abstracts and deeds on microfilm may also be accessed in the History Room.
