going on in the world politically, with the environment and the community. He is a founder of the Carrboro Community Garden and the Carrboro Greenspace. He raises chickens and grows a garden at his home. My husband and I used to buy some of the things we didn't grow in a Coa in Redlands every Saturday. Samuel and his partner, Michal, do the same at the Carrboro Farmers' Market. I am very proud of my son, Sammy, and hope he will be elected alderman.


