SPOTLIGHT: DAVE LIPPMAN

It's certain to be a lively evening. Lippman, a former Chapel Hillian, has satirized issues relating to human rights and empire for decades. Among his personas are "George Shrub, the world's only known singing CIA agent" and "Wild Bill Bailout, the Bard of the Bankers."

Within Lippman's repertoire are "Brother Can You Spare a Diamond," "What the Frack?" "I Hate Wal-Mart," "Your Car is Disgusting" and "Sgt. Pepper Spray & Heads Clubbed Band."

"With his astute observations about the American political system and his sly, often underplayed humor, Lippman is a national treasure," says the Los Angeles Herald-Examiner.
