

If you want more of an adventure, you can take a mountain hike just by traveling a few minutes north to Occoneechee Mountain on the edge of Hillsborough. It's now part of the state park system, and once you make the steep walk up to the looking-off place, you'll have a being-in-themountains sensation.

This is one of my favorite local natural areas and I frequently take outof-town visitors there to get a flavor of Western North Carolina without the long drive. You may be surprised to discover an extensive shrub layer of the evergreen mountain laurel, Kalmia angustifolia, with a few rhododendron, Rhododendron catabiense, here and there and a groundcover of galax, Galax aphylla, an evergreen-leaved wildflower common throughout the Carolina mountain regions. Visitors appreciate learning that these isolated pockets of mountain species in our eastern Piedmont are small "relict" plant

communities of former lce Age boreal forests, left in place clinging to coolish, north-facing, rocky creek and river bluffs.

Whether you stay close to home or travel a few miles away, take time at this turning over of the year for a woods walk. And even if you are accompanied by a few other folks, stop and be silent for at least 60 seconds, hear the sounds the forest makes, and let that guide you into the New Year.

hat better way to start the New Year than with a Cat Baby story? For the newcomer

wondering who is Cat Baby — think about the movie *Radio* and you'll get the picture. From the mid-'50s until his passing at age 58 in 1993, George "Cat Baby" Cannada of Carrboro was the unofficial beloved team mascot of Chapel Hill High School football. Here we see him posing proudly with an unidentified CHHS cheerleader during a fall 1967 football game that I was covering for Jim Shumaker's *Chapel Hill Weekly*.

The longtime paper "boy" famously called himself — and everybody else in town, regardless of their station — "Cat Baby." He also used the short but drawn out version "Caaaat!" as both a greeting and an exclamation. Ask anybody who grew up here and they're liable to have a Cat Baby story. This is one of Charlie Byrd's favorites: In the early '70s, John Boone of Carrboro took George to Washington D.C., and as they drove past the White House Boone said to George, "Look, Cat; that's where the president lives!" To which George exclaimed, "[Bleep]! I didn't know Mr. Friday lived up here! CAT!"
