ORDER

ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION TO DISMISS

I. Background

1. III S.G.C. § 732 (A) states that “before trial of an action, a party may file a motion to dismiss the claim . . . if justice requires.”
2. On March 27, 2013, Student Congress took legislative action which nullified the effect of the alleged legislative misconduct at issue in the case and which returned Plaintiffs to the position in which they stood prior to the alleged legislative misconduct.
3. Plaintiffs acknowledge that due to the aforementioned legislative action, the case is now moot as they have received satisfactory relief from said legislative action and there is thus no additional or necessary relief that the Court can provide Plaintiffs at this time.
4. Accordingly, Plaintiffs have filed a motion to dismiss 12 SSC 002.
5. Based on these facts, the Court finds that III S.G.C. Sec. 732 (A) requires the dismissal of the case.

II. Order

Pursuant to III S.G.C. § 732 (A) and upon Plaintiffs’ motion, the Student Supreme Court of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill hereby orders 12 SSC 002

DISMISSED.
