
I. Allegation of Grounds For the Order Sought

- 1. III S.G.C. Section 732 (A) states: "Before trial of an action, a party may file a motion to dismiss the claim...if justice requires."
- 2. Student Body President Will Leimenstoll vetoed the cause of this action, SCB-94-242, a Bill to Have SSSC Hear Ammunition Requests, on March 19, 2013.
- 3. The Student Congress upheld the President's veto on March 26, 2013, thus ending the legislative journey of the bill, which cannot become law.
- 4. While Plaintiffs contend that a legislative error was committed in the passage of the bill, the upholding of the veto returns Plaintiffs to the position in which they stood prior to the legislative error.
- 5. There is no remedy the Supreme Court can offer as the alleged wrongs have been addressed, and the merits of this case become moot.

II. Order Sought

Plaintiffs thank the Court for its time and attention paid to this matter and respectfully request that the Court dismiss 12-SSC-002 by necessity.
