Adam, I made two recommendations to Jacki after the conference ended, so perhaps they will be mentioned through her input. None-the-less, in response to your request, I have two recommendations:

1. UNC should issue a position paper to define a) public policy considerations for the state of North Carolina, and b) a holistic, multifaceted, collaborative statewide system of public education, first responder training, services for victims, and enforcement and prosecution of traffickers.
2. Most trafficking-related public education, training, services and enforcement/prosecution are inevitably local and must be locally implemented, coordinated, etc. I think your state-level trafficking task force could have value if it connects with local trafficking task forces. I believe there are five population centers in North Carolina – I recommend that interdisciplinary, multijurisdictional human trafficking task forces be created in each area. The statewide task force should support those local efforts.
